

Declaration to RoHS-conformity and WEEE-guideline

Basis and Requirement

The RoHS- and WEEE guidelines are valid in the area of the European Union.

In view of environmental pollution, the guidelines regulate within the EU the launch in the market and the waste disposal of electrical and electronic equipment.

The EU-guideline 2002/95EC RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances), regulates the concentration of: Pb-Lead, Hg-Mercury, Cr6-Hexavalent Chromium, PBB-polybrominated Biphenyls, PBDE-Polybrominated Dihpenyl ethers with <0,1% by weight (1000 ppm) and CD-Cadmium with <0,01% by weight (1000 ppm) of electrical and electronic instruments, placed on the market from July 1, 2006 onwards.

In combination with the RoHS-guideline the EU-guideline 20002/96/EC, WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) has passed.

Prior goal of the WEEE is to avoid, reduce, reduce as well as th recycle old electrical and electronic instruments. Stationary machines and theirs components are exempted of the EU-guideline 20002/96/EC.

Declaration to RoHS-conformity

Automatikprodukter (AP) is world wide active.

We are conscious about the environmental protection and the conservation of the natural resources.

For this reasons, we committed ourselves to guarantee that our products gradually comply with the EU-guideline RoHS.

The products of AP are not concerned by the EU-guideline 2002/95/EC (RoHS).

Our products belong to category 9 (Measurement and control equipment in Industry), which are not specified in the area within which the law is operative (article 2, paragraph 1).

Although the RoHS-guideline and the deadline of July 1, 2006 are not binding for us, we will execute the conversion in an economically sensible manner, as swift as possible.

We will launch in the market only RoHS-conformal products, beginning from the prescribed date.

The actual delivery date for RoHS compliance products will depend on our inventory status please contact our sales department for details).

The directive does not apply to spare parts for repair, or reuse, of electronic equipment put on the market before July, 2006 (Article 2(3). This is to allow old equipment to be maintained with spare parts and to ensure that old electrical and electronic equipment is reused.

This derogation is explicitly limited to old equipment, i.e. put on market before July, 2006.
